



Eve's Space Mission Statement

We will support women to make changes in their lives which enable them to reduce and stop offending behaviour.

The Service aims to:-

- Reduce women's offending and re-offending
- Assist in ensuring that it is only women who pose a risk to the public who go to prison by providing alternative provision to sentences and prevention work.
- Increase the number of women accessing and being sustained in appropriate community provision

Service Delivery:-

In order to achieve the above aims, Eve's Space will:-

- Engage with women at a range of locations in Bolton and in custodial settings.
- Provide individual and group programmes at the Urban Restore Centre and other locations to address women's' needs such as education and training, substance misuse and community integration. These programmes will be delivered by key partner agencies and relevant community services, as well as Eve's Space staff.
- Provide a 'statutory service' for women who are supervised under the terms of a court order and/or licence. Working with all women offenders will be a core function of the team and a shared responsibility for services.
- Provide a drop-in facility, available at designated times in different locations, enabling women to access information, advice, guidance and crisis management.
- Refer and signpost clients, and encourage engagement with other relevant services as required. We will provide access to specialist advice and support including medical services, mental health services, social and community services.
- Actively promote the project to potential referral sources in order to generate and maximise referrals.
- Undertake a comprehensive assessment of risks and needs alongside all women referred and create an individual support plan with clear objectives to address areas of risk and need. This will be regularly reviewed.
