<p>Monday 7th January & Tuesday 8th January Severe Weather Emergency Protocol (SWEPE) is a power that a local authority has to safeguard rough sleepers during a sustained period of very cold weather. It involves a coordinated response to get rough sleepers off the streets & into shelters & temporary accommodation. Our Vision is that no-one, whatever their background or circumstances, should have to endure the desperation & indignity of living on the streets of Bolton at any time. Our Aim is to provide overnight emergency shelter during extreme weather & to prevent any deaths on the streets wherever possible. We are leading on the recruitment & training of around 300 volunteers & hosting one of the venues. Please pray as we develop this project and support a new alliance helping rough sleepers in the town.</p>		<p>Wednesday 9th January We are really believing again this year that God is going to break through into our guests lives at Winter Watch and we are going to see 'captives set free'. Please join us in praying for all those who will come through our doors. Pray that they will come with an open heart ready to receive God's Love and Mercy.</p>
